The articles will be sourced from OENO One and other scientific and technical journals. They will be published in English, French, German, Italian, Spanish and Portuguese.

Why should my institution become a partner?

> IVES is supported by 13 leading universities and research institutes in vine and wine sciences and is looking for more partners to increase its network. > By becoming an institutional member, you will contribute to the strategy and development of IVES and its journals, including OENO One, with a right to vote at the General Assembly, which is held yearly. Furthermore, all researchers from your institute or university will be allowed to publish for free in OENO One (researchers from non-affiliated institutes pay 500 €/published article).

Why should my company become a partner?

> In 2019, we will launch IVES Technical Reviews, a technical journal specially designed to transfer research to end users. Research papers will be digested and published in a format accessible to professionals and reviewed by scientists. IVES Technical Reviews will be edited in six languages (English, French, German, Italian, Spanish and Portuguese). Once a year, we organize an IVES – OENO One Science meeting where the staff of our private partners meet researchers and network with other partners. At the meeting, researchers who have recently published in OENO One present their work in an accessible format. It is a unique opportunity to exchange with researchers and colleagues.


