I am happy to look back at 2022. Just a quick glance because it's equally important to look ahead. IVES continued to grow in 2022, in every respect. Thanks to its 3 online Open Access media - OENO One, IVES Technical Reviews and IVES Conference Series - it has proven to be a reliable and trusted source for free information for everybody with a vested interest in the science and general knowledge of grapes and wines and in their practical application. The number of readers, members and partners increased again which is a show of confidence and the confirmation of the value and the strategy of IVES. The networking opportunities were particularly appreciated as researchers and practitioners had the desire and the pleasure to exchange and share, a crucial element IVES is committed to. The number of submissions and published articles in OENO One hit a new record high confirming its leadership among the specialized grape-wine journals. In the process, its Impact Factor increased to 3 for the first time, an unambiguous sign of its notoriety. IVES Technical Reviews had around 100,000 different readers, an 8-fold increase over 2021, and IVES Conference Series closed agreements with many major grape-wine conferences after only one year since its launch, with over 2,000 documents available. Looking ahead, IVES is preparing for the future of the rapidly changing publishing landscape, always committed to serve the needs of its members and partners. Stay tuned.

In 2022, due to the pandemic, the **General Assembly** of IVES and the **editorial board meetings** of the journals were held in February 2022 through videoconference.

IVES SCIENCE MEETING

The IVES Science Meeting 2022 was held on 16 and 17 June 2022.

This annual private event is dedicated to the members and partners of the association. It allows professionals from the wine and vine fields to take part in the life of the association and to network with colleagues and researchers. In 2022, our members and partners had the opportunity to meet at **Château Brane-Cantenac** (Gironde, France).

The first day was dedicated to **scientific conferences** and ended with a **wonderful tasting of our partners' wines**. During this event, 6 speakers presented their work, recently published in our journals OENO One or IVES Technical Reviews.

IVES' research journal



OENO One is a peer-reviewed research journal in the field of vine, grape and wine sciences. Manuscripts are evaluated by qualified reviewers selected by the editorial board.

Articles are published online with Open Access and are accessible for free.

In 2022, the editorial board was composed of 2 editors-in-chief and 72 associate editors.

IVES Technical Reviews is a peer-reviewed technical journal. Its objective is to provide high quality scientific content to professionals in their native language. In 2022, the editorial board was constituted of more than 70 researchers and professionals of the wine industry in equal shares. Articles are published online with Open Access.

Thanks to the support of high-visibility partners, articles are available in 6 languages (English, French, German, Italian, Spanish and Portuguese) and are accessible for free.
